### Numeracy

Year 1 -Count, read and write numbers to 20. Begin to add and subtract. Recognise 1p and 2p coins.

Compare lengths. Recognise simple patterns. Know days of the week. Read time to 'the hour'. Start to solve mathematical problems.

Year 2 - Count, read and write numbers to 100. Understand the operations of addition and subtraction. Recognise all coins. Use units of time, measure lengths. Extend number sequences, recognising odd and even numbers.

### Literacy

Year 1 - Stories with familiar settings, signs, labels, captions, lists, instructions, Rhymes with predictable and repetitive patterns.

Year 2- Stories with familiar settings, instructions and a variety of poems with familiar settings.
