

Key Stage Two Upper Phase

Year 5

Literacy– Novels, stories and poems from variety of cultures. Performance poetry, persuasive writing letters, dictionary and thesaurus work.

Numeracy– Place value, multiplication and division, fractions, decimals, percentages, ratio and proportion, handling data, problem solving, shape and space, measures.

Science-Life processes and living things. Life cycles. Healthy living.

RE-Religious festivals and ceremonies to explore events that mark stages of life in-faith communities.

Geography-The study of St. Lucia as a contrasting locality outside the British Isles.

Art and Design–Textiles-a story illustration represented in textiles.

Design Technology- “Lighting it up” - Investigating electrical circuits and designing light circuits.

PE-Tuesdays. Games and outdoor education.

Music-Listening, appreciation of a range of music, singing and composition.

ICT- Typing skills, monitor environmental changes and conditions. Spreadsheets. Research and word processing skills.
