

Key Stage Two-Middle Phase

Year 3

Literacy – A variety of themes are explored this term; Information texts, sequencing writing, performing poetry, looking at the work of different authors, developing note making skills, writing letters, working with alphabetical texts and dialogue and plays.

Numeracy – This term's works involves revisiting many themes which include; estimation skills, use of the four operations, measuring length, using fractions, various forms of problem solving and working with shapes.

Science – This term we will look at 'light and shadows'. We will be studying how shadows are formed, how they change during the day and examining different materials to see if they are transparent or opaque.

History – We will be learning the key skills of historical enquiry round the theme of castles and medieval life. We will visit Warwick Castle on Thursday, 22nd May.

Geography – Our learning in Geography will be based on the theme of the British Isles and will include countries, mountains, rivers and cities. We will include a lot of map work using Ordnance Survey maps.

Design & Technology – using tubing and syringes we will be creating simple pneumatic toys or models. This will develop skills of cutting, sticking and working with card.

Art & Design – this topic involves the designing, sketching and making of a model sculpture. Skills include designing, sketching and working with modroc or clay.

ICT – 'Logo' a simple graphics programming language will be the main area being developed this term.

RE – the topic being followed this term is The Bible. What makes it so special to Christians, how it is divided up and how Christians use it in their daily lives.

PE – In athletics the themes of running, jumping and throwing will be explored. Games will explore skills associated with fielding. Tuesday and Thursday will be our PE days. Outdoor Adventurous Activity. Athletics.
