Dear Parents,

Further to my previous correspondence regarding the Year 6 residential visit to London. I regret to inform you that we have just been let down by the Crystal Palace, which is closed for refurbishment.

I am sure that you will agree that the safety of your children is paramount and at such short notice I am not prepared to rely on other accommodation that has not been vetted by ourselves.

I have therefore rearranged all the activities to fit into one day, **Wednesday 23rd April**.

The new itinerary is as follows:-

07.00 am	Leave school.
10.00 am	Arrive at London Zoo. The visit includes, a South American Rainforest guided workshop. We will have a hot meal in the café.
05.00 pm	London Eye
07.30 pm	Adelphi Theatre. Joseph and His Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat.
10.00 pm	Approx. time to leave London and return home.

Whilst I realise that this will be a late return, (12.00 am – 1.00 am) it will enable all activities to be experienced. The children will be authorised to remain at home on **Thursday 24th April** to recover.
